One in seven (14.2%) children and young people under the age of 18 will have lived with domestic violence at some point in their childhood. 61.7% of women in refuge on the Day to Count 2017 had children (aged under 18) with them (Women's Aid, 2018 – data from Women's Aid Annual Survey 2017). Between January 2005 and August 2015 (inclusive) 19 children and two women were killed by perpetrators of domestic abuse in circumstances relating to child contact (formally or informally arranged ...
